Alberta's bio-industry is rich with history and innovation. World-class researchers and institutions have spurred incredible new company creation throughout the past 25 years. From early start-ups in the 60's and 70's, Alberta has grown to become the fourth largest region in Canada and the 14th largest region in the Americas.

Alberta has a history of excellence in health biotechnology, and growing expertise in agricultural biotechnology, environment, industrial bioproducts, bioinformatics, and nano-

technology. The bio-industry is a key component of a sustainable knowledge-based economy in Alberta.
