The Institute of Health Economics (IHE) is an independent, not-for-profit organization with key competencies in health economics and decision analytic modelling, health technology assessment, and knowledge transfer/exchange. The mission of the IHE is to inform coordinated, innovative, evidence-guided health policy and practice.

The IHE has two key platforms that support partnership with industry and other stakeholders: the Life Sciences SME Commercialization Platform, and the Health Technology Innovation Platform:

- **Life Sciences SME Commercialization Platform** supports innovators with an early-stage health technology assessment to offer an understanding of the commercial potential of technology, considering the headroom available for innovation, and the likely ability for technology to provide sufficient value to be attractive to payers. It also supports market-ready companies to quantify their value proposition to help them secure trial and adoption.
- **Health Technology Innovation Platform (HTIP)** facilitates collaboration between a number of innovative pharmaceutical organizations and key public sector stakeholders to develop methods, with a focus on real world evidence, and legal frameworks that support risk-balanced and value-based licensing and reimbursement of therapeutics with considerable evidentiary uncertainty.

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
